Southwestern Prerequisite Planning Chart

A minimum of 30 credits of the 50 listed below must be completed by the end of Fall term 2011, **including Anatomy and Physiology I (BI 231)**. Official transcripts must be included in the application packet for completed classes, unless taken at SOCC. Official transcripts for classes completed elsewhere Winter term are due by April 13, 2012. All 50 credits must be earned with a “C” grade or higher prior to the first term of the nursing program Fall 2012. If Pass/Fail grades are used, a “Pass” grade equals a “C”. The most recent grade will be used for classes that are retaken. Science and computer science classes must be completed within seven years (taken Fall term 2005 or more recently). **All fields must be completed.**

Classes taken at other colleges can only be deemed equivalent by SOCC’s Transcript Evaluator based on curriculum content. Classes with the same course title and/or number may not transfer in as equivalent.
