He has worked at JPL in Pasadena, the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) in Menlo Park, and is currently Department Head of Geological Sciences at UO. Dr. Weldon serves on the executive committee of the Working Group on California Earthquake Probabilities. His talk will summarize what has been learned from the recent Japanese earthquake and its implications for the next giant quake off the Oregon Coast.
