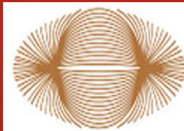

She earned her MS & Ph.D. at Università degli Studi di Perugia, followed by postdoctoral work at Rice University. After studying plate boundaries all over the world, Dr. Magnani recently had a major discovery of a previously unknown fault line beneath the Mississippi River. She has been featured in the PBS documentary Earthquakes in the Midwest and on their Nova ScienceNOW Web site as an "Ask the Expert."
