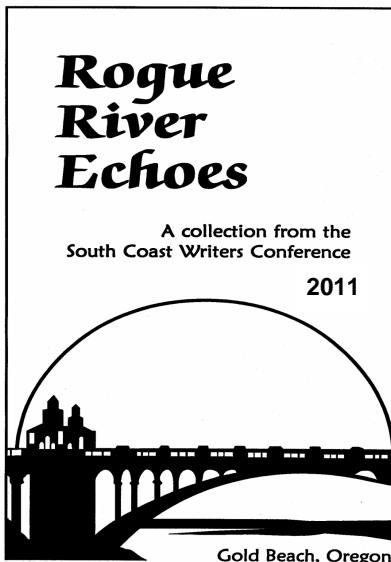

Publication in the anthology will be determined on the basis of excellence, readability, and to some extent, brevity. Written work must not exceed 900 words. Art work and photographs must be suitable for black and white reproduction at 300dpi. More information will be available at the conference.
