BOARD MEMBER COMPENSATION, PRIVILEGES AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENTS

The Board of Education receives no compensation for their services, but shall be allowed reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in the performance of their official duties. Travel, meals, lodging and registration fee expenses shall be reimbursed to members travelling on official board business, when such attendance has been approved by the Board. The College does not pay for meals, lodging or other costs associated with persons accompanying board members.

In an effort for the Board to engage both on campus and in the community as part of their responsibilities of being informed about the College, members may be reimbursed for paid admission fees at College events, when such admission is required for the general public. Board members are also eligible to receive some of the same privileges as employees (dependents are excluded) including:

- 1) Waived Credit Hour Tuition
- 2) Bookstore Discount
- 3) Entry to College-Sponsored Events
- 4) Library Privileges
