

EMERGENCY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This scholarship through the Southwestern Oregon Community College Foundation is available to students registered at Southwestern Oregon Community College full or part-time who need assistance with temporary and surmountable financial difficulties and/or emergencies. **The goal with this assistance is to ensure students are able to remain enrolled and complete their studies.** This scholarship is supported through the Richard Grossman Student Support Scholarship fund and the Olive Bridge Emergency scholarship fund. **Awards are limited to <u>ONE PER STUDENT</u> each academic year from each emergency fund; the typical maximum amount awarded is up to \$500 per fund. Students must complete the entire application and meet criteria listed below for consideration:**

- ✓ Must be a current student at Southwestern (full or part-time)
- ✓ Student is facing a temporary and surmountable financial difficulty and/or emergency
- ✓ Must list at least one staff member for reference who is familiar with circumstances
