BP: 2310 Regular Meetings of the Board of Education

Purpose

To define the legal structure of regular meetings of the Board of Education as granted by the Oregon Attorney General and establish the date and place of these business meetings.

Statement

Regular Meetings of the Board of Education of Southwestern Oregon Community College are business meetings of the board which are held in Public. The Oregon Public Meetings Law is a public attendance law, not a public participation law. The right of public attendance guaranteed by the Oregon Public Meetings Law does not include the right to participate by public testimony or comment.

Meetings of the Board of Education shall be held on the 4th Monday of the month unless otherwise noted in the board agenda. Regular Meetings of the Board will normally be held at 1988 Newmark Avenue, Coos Bay, OR 97420 in the Tioga Board Room 505. If meetings last longer than three hours, a motion to continue must be passed by a majority vote of the Board. If necessary, Executive Session deliberations shall be scheduled.

The Clerk of the Board shall provide public meeting notice of the time and place of Board meetings at least four days prior to the regular meeting.
