BP 7130 Prohibition of Incentive Compensation

Purpose:

To establish and clarify the prohibition of incentive compensation of any activity related to procuring enrollment, securing financial aid, or granting financial assistance to prospective students.

Statement:

Southwestern Oregon Community College shall not provide any commission, bonus, or other incentive payment based, directly or indirectly, on the success in securing enrollments or financial aid, to any person or entity engaged in any student recruiting or admission activities or in making decisions regarding the award of student financial assistance. Employees covered by this ban shall be referred to as “covered employees” for purposes of this policy.
