BP 3550 Illicit Drug Free Environment and Prevention Program

Purpose

To establish and define an illicit drug and alcohol use prevention program that meets regulatory requirements.

Statement

The Board of Education, recognizing the harmful effect of substance abuse on students and society, directs administration to establish procedures and rules prohibiting the on-campus possession or use of alcohol and illicit drugs (see Student Handbook).

The President will assure the following areas are addressed:

- 1. Campus prohibition;
- 2. Educational programs;
- 3. Prevention programs;
- 4. Student assistance and/or referral program; and

The President shall assure that the College distributes annually to each student and employee the information required by the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989 and complies with other requirements of the Act.
