Federal Stafford Loans are either subsidized or unsubsidized. A subsidized loan is awarded based on financial need, and the interest payments do not accrue until you begin repayment. An unsubsidized loan is awarded based on cost of attendance, and the interest accrual starts when the loan is disbursed. **You may request to change your loan a maximum of one time during an academic year.**

- ☐ You must be registered in a minimum of 6 credits that go towards your declared degree.

- ☐ Must file a FAFSA at www.studentaid.gov.
